THE MARVELOUS LIGHT



“The pain is still there. It’s deep in my heart. But we keep pressing on, ministering the Gospel.” —Pastor Samuel

In the remote villages of Ethiopia where Pastor Samuel* serves, the stakes are high. The region is dominated by witchcraft, and when the movement of Jesus Christ began sweeping through villages, people stopped paying the witchdoctors. For those whose power and livelihood depend on keeping communities enslaved to fear and superstition, the Gospel represents an existential threat—and they fight back violently.

Pastor Samuel’s father-in-law knew this cost. As a devoted pastor serving multiple churches across the region, he loved Jesus deeply and couldn’t stop sharing the hope he’d found in Christ, even as the risks grew.

Then darkness struck. While traveling for ministry, an armed group abducted the elderly pastor. Samuel received a chilling phone call from the captors. He begged for his father-in-law’s release. Instead, they sent an ultimatum: the pastor would not renounce Jesus, so they would kill him.

Samuel’s father-in-law was murdered for his faith. The same fate awaited Samuel if he didn’t stop preaching.

But at the memorial service, something powerful happened. In their grief, the church clung to the light of Jesus—and the Holy Spirit moved mightily. The persecution meant to silence the Gospel instead ignited it.



Thanks to your prayers and generosity, the Bible in Ethiopia’s Oromo language launched in 2023. Now, believers can read the Word of God in the language they think, pray, and dream in.

What’s the impact of having Scripture in a language you can understand? When 17,600 Bibles and Bible resources were infused into churches in Mozambique, a remarkable thing happened:

New church plants grew

Increase in church attendance by children and youth

New believers came to faith

Orphans were brought into families in the church

This represents twice the growth of control groups where no Scripture resources were available.

“Even if we get killed, the church will go on,” Samuel declared as hundreds gathered to worship and praise Jesus. Rather than retreating in fear, the community chose to press forward with even greater boldness.

Today, Samuel’s life remains under constant threat. “I don’t know what will happen next,” he admits. “They threaten me. They threaten my people. But we will not stop preaching the Gospel.”

The results speak for themselves.

In just the past month, Samuel and his network have reached over 5,700 young people with the Gospel. They’ve baptized more than 1,000 new believers—former slaves to witchcraft now walking, as Pastor Samuel puts it, in the “marvelous light” of Christ.

“People were living in such darkness under the influence of witchcraft and evil spirits,”


Samuel explains. “But when the light of the Gospel is preached, everything changes. The Holy Spirit is moving. We cannot be held down—it’s beyond explaining with words.”

You are part of the light that’s growing in Ethiopia. Each new believer receives something precious after baptism: their very first Bible, provided through your partnership with Biblica.

“My people can’t afford a Bible,” Samuel says with deep gratitude. “The Bible they receive is precious to them. This is the biggest gift they will ever receive in their lives.”

He pauses, then adds with conviction: “All this joy, all this celebration, all this planting of churches, getting out of the darkness—it could not be happening without Biblica.”

Cuba

FROM BLACKOUT TO LIGHT

Pastor Raúl* stood on the coast of Cuba, staring across the dark waters toward the distant lights of Guantanamo Bay. “We’re on the blackout side,” he remembers thinking. “I want to be in the light.”

It was the 1990s. The Soviet Union had collapsed, taking Cuba’s economy with it. For decades, atheism had been government policy. Now, devastating poverty gripped the island. Desperate young Cubans like Raúl saw only one escape: risking everything on makeshift rafts or swimming to freedom.

Raúl began training with friends, preparing for the deadly journey. Some of them tried. They didn’t survive.

His mother begged him to find another way. His father pressed twelve dollars into his son’s hands—everything he had. “Put this in God’s hands and it will be more,” he said with prophetic faith.

That twelve dollars changed everything.

Instead of fleeing Cuba, Raúl discovered his calling: bringing light to his homeland. He made it to Ecuador, where he connected with Bible distribution networks. The need was staggering—no bookstores to sell Bibles in Cuba, and the rapidly growing house church movement was starving for God’s Word.



In 2025, you helped deliver SD cards to Cuba, putting an entire digital library of Scripture and study material into waiting hands.

How the Bible on SD Card Is Helping Cuba:

- SD cards travel where print Bibles can’t, allowing the Bible to be read and distributed in areas where persecution and government bans exist.
- A single SD card carries the Bible in many languages, biblical study materials, audio Bibles, the Jesus Film, and more.
- One card can reach a limitless number of people, making the reach and impact of these cards hard to calculate.
- Cards can be copied and distributed, or materials on the cards can be shared from device to device.



Through a simple tap, the Bible on SD is shared. Like a flame passed from torch to torch, the light of the Gospel is growing in dark places.

“The church is growing so fast,” Raúl explains. “In a country where it’s difficult to find food and gas, imagine how hard it is to find Bibles.”

Then Biblica pioneered an innovative solution: tiny SD cards loaded with complete Bibles, devotionals, and discipleship resources. Cuban believers can slip these cards into their phones, instantly accessing God’s Word and sharing it with others.

“If you bring SD cards that they can put in their phone and they have Bibles and resources...that idea from Biblica is amazing,” Raúl says.

The impact spreads like wildfire. Pastors tap their phones together, transferring the precious digital cargo. University students share Scripture with classmates. House

church leaders finally have curriculum for their congregations.

“We cannot calculate where that message is going to go,” Raúl marvels. “It has the possibility to be shared instantly!”

Today, the most important revolution happening in Cuba isn’t political—it’s spiritual. And it started with a father’s twelve dollars and faith that God could multiply it into something magnificent.

“When you are giving, you are investing in lives,” Raúl wants you to know. “When you are giving, you are loving future generations.”

The Gospel is working miracles in Cuba, and you’re helping to light the way.

Indonesia

ISLANDS OF LIGHT

Scattered across 17,000 remote islands, Indonesia hides a troubling reality behind its tropical beauty: countless women live trapped in cycles of abuse and trauma, searching desperately for safety and hope.

It was into the darkness of this reality that Johanna was born, but the Lord would use her to bring hope to thousands of women. "I always dreamt of being a journalist since I was in high school," Johanna recalls. But she could not have known that God would redirect her calling entirely.

Instead of traditional journalism, He led her to launch Indonesia's first Christian television station, Pijar TV. Her mission became clear: reach the 95% of Indonesians who still watch television with the light of Christ.

A second breakthrough came when a Biblica employee brought a book called Asha into Johanna's office—a trauma healing program for women built around the Gospel of John.

"I saw that this is the book of John, but it has stories of broken women in it with their own traumas," Johanna explains. "I felt confirmation in every page of the book. I kept reading the stories in it, and I knew we needed to create some movies out of these stories." Production on this important project is currently underway.

Through Asha, traumatized women find safety while encountering Jesus through His "I Am" declarations in John's Gospel. The nine-week program guides them from isolation to community, from despair to baptism, from darkness to light.



"I can truly testify that this book has brought real hope into my life," an Asha graduate shares. "It is a treasure, a precious gift from God."

"Too many people here are living through hell on earth," says one leader in Asia Pacific. "When you share the Gospel, it goes straight to their hearts, and they come to Christ."

In 2025, you helped send innovative technologies to share the Bible with seekers aching for God's hope in oppressive religions, governments, and marriages. Here are just a few of the ways Asia Pacific was impacted through your commitment to light the way:

Because of you, the Asha program was translated into 4 new languages last year—bringing the total to 12. Thank you for delivering the healing love of Jesus to women around the world.

The need is overwhelming. One viewer shared her story of an abusive marriage, feeling completely alone until she saw Pijar TV’s helpline number on screen.

“I have been able to share my story with them and receive prayer,” she testified. “This has brought me so much peace. My life is very different now... I felt the love of Jesus, was baptized, and now I attend church.”

“That’s the real effect of Jesus in someone’s life,” Johanna reflects. “His love has an eternal effect, and it’s really happening in this life.”

Today, Pijar TV receives over 200,000 responses monthly through social media, WhatsApp, and Facebook. The network now has the potential to reach 120 million Indonesian women with Asha’s healing message.

“Through the many choices that we have in the digital world, having one that is actually lighting our way to God’s Word is very important,” Johanna says. “We’re actually leading these people to Christ.”

In the world’s largest island archipelago, isolated women are discovering they’re not alone—and finding their way to the light.

LIGHT FROM ABOVE



Pastor Ahmad* never expected to find home in a graveyard.

Growing up in a Middle Eastern country where Christianity is outlawed, he endured years of violence and abuse. At sixteen, desperate and broken, he fled his situation with nowhere to go. An old cemetery became his home—for five years, he lived among the tombstones with only a sleeping bag for comfort.

“I was always looking for the God who is love,” Ahmad recalls. “I was emotionally and physically broken, with so much hate in my heart.”

As a musician from a Muslim background, Ahmad had long conversations with God through his songs and poetry. But the religion he knew offered no grace, no free gift of love. Everything came with a price.

Then a Christian friend, recognizing Ahmad’s desperate situation, invited him to attend service at an underground church.

“I heard the Gospel. I heard the Word of God,” Ahmad remembers. “Oh! The Word of God changed my life! Then I heard the pastor say, ‘God is love.’ And I said, ‘Yes, yes! I was looking for you!’”

During worship, Ahmad experienced something extraordinary. When he opened his eyes, the church was filled with brilliant light from above, as if the roof had disappeared. “When I saw Him, I jumped and said, ‘Jesus, you are my Lord, You are my Savior.’”

The congregation gave Ahmad his first Bible—cherished as a love letter from God, it quickly became his most precious possession.



When the Good News reaches those waiting in the MENA area, everything changes. Upon receiving Scripture in their own language, one new believer marveled, “In this small book, there is a great Spirit—there is love and salvation.”

In countries where being a Christian can cost you everything, God’s Church is advancing. Like in the book of Acts, people are meeting Jesus in dreams and sharing their faith boldly.

But they need Bibles to grow in their faith and share the Gospel. In 2025, your gift helped come alongside underground believers by providing them with Bibles in strategic formats. Together, we:

But following Jesus in this region comes with severe consequences. Government agents sought to kill Ahmad and other new believers, beating them and threatening their lives. Yet instead of despair, Ahmad found joy, remembering what Matthew 5:11 says about being blessed when persecuted for righteousness.

“The Bible doesn’t say when you have persecution, ‘cry,’” Ahmad explains. “It says, ‘rejoice.’”

Today, Ahmad and his wife serve through a television ministry reaching people across the Middle East who have never heard about Jesus. Broadcasting by satellite and operating through social media, they regularly receive Bible requests—often from curious not-yet-believers asking, “Can I have a Bible?”

Through partnerships with Biblica, Ahmad has received over 20,000 Bibles to distribute through underground churches and small groups. Brave believers carry these precious books back to their homeland, knowing the risks.

“They say, ‘If I die this way, this is the best way to die,’” Ahmad shares about these courageous Christians. “They don’t care about dying when they’re giving the Bible to their people.”

In a region where over 50 million people are living in spiritual darkness, those 20,000 Bibles represent just the beginning. “People are thirsty for the love of God,” Ahmad says. “The Bible is our light for our way. The Bible is our guidance. The Bible is sweeter than honey and more valuable than gold.”

Where darkness once reigned, light is breaking through—one Bible at a time.

Gospel Advancement

FROM ROMAN ROADS TO AI

Technology has always propelled the Gospel forward.

When Jesus walked the earth, Roman roads had just connected the known world—250,000 miles stretching from Rome to Israel, reaching as far as modern-day Scotland. This engineering marvel enabled movement and connection previously unimaginable. These roads became the foundation for fulfilling the Great Commission. When Jesus

commanded “Go and make disciples of all nations,” the path had literally been laid before His disciples.

We now stand at a similar crossroads.

Today’s AI technology is helping to make completion of the Great Commission possible. AI-assisted translation programs are cutting decades off Bible translation timelines, bringing Scripture to languages spoken at the literal ends of the earth.

If the Great Commission launched at the perfect technological moment, we’re witnessing the perfect moment for its completion.

Biblica is leading the charge. Early trials revealed a crucial insight: AI becomes a

powerful accelerant when placed in the hands of local teams with the right tools—unlocking breakthrough efficiency not just for Biblica, but also for partners across the Bible translation sector.

Simply put, the right people plus the right technology equals trusted results.

Speed and Accuracy:

- 1 Experts work with native speakers to collect data and build an AI model. This is then used to create a first draft.
- 2 Native speakers refine the translation with cultural, theological and linguistic precision.
- 3 Mentors & church leaders ensure theological accuracy.
- 4 Communities review the translation for fluency and acceptance.

What once took a decade now takes 3-7 years. In the process, something remarkable is happening: translators are coming to Christ as they work. The process itself is becoming a discipleship movement as Scripture comes alive around the world.

From Roman roads to AI translation, God uses technology for eternal purposes. The goal that once seemed impossible is now within sight: God’s Word accessible to all people by 2033.



Biblical Answers, Anytime, Anywhere

Biblica's AI Chatbot is an interactive tool that helps pastors prepare sermons, ensures accuracy in preaching, and answers complex theological questions. Drawing from the NIV and our other translations, the chatbot quotes Scripture with 100% accuracy—unlike most language models that are only 50-60% correct. It's directly connected to our Study Bible notes, providing trusted theological guidance.

Launched in September, the chatbot is available on the web and multiple

platforms. More than 98% of its usage comes from outside the United States—exactly where it's needed most.

For pastors serving without resources, the Bible Chatbot is putting seminary-level biblical knowledge in their pockets.

If AI is going to shape the future, it should be on the frontlines of human flourishing—useful for the Gospel, grounded in truth, and built on biblically sound values. That's why Biblica created the Bible Chatbot, currently available in 9 languages.

THE PROBLEM

Frontline pastors in developing regions lack access to biblical education. A Study Bible in Egypt costs an entire month's salary—\$1,600 in U.S. equivalent. It is estimated that only 5% of pastors worldwide have formal theological training.



THE SOLUTION

Five years ago, Biblica began creating the first open-licensed, simplified, digital-first Study Bible. After four years of development, it launched last August. Within the first year, half a million people downloaded it—primarily frontline pastors in places like Egypt, Zimbabwe, and India.

Where Innovation Meets Mission: *The Global Missional AI Summit*

Before ChatGPT made headlines, a small group of innovators gathered around a bold question: *How could artificial intelligence accelerate the Great Commission?*

Six years later, that question has sparked a global movement—now the largest gathering of Christians exploring AI's role in ministry. Attendance has doubled each year as momentum builds around **Missional AI**, the flagship conference at the intersection of ministry and technology.

Biblica has the privilege of being the lead organizer of Missional AI, which is quickly becoming recognized as a pioneering forum for faith and innovation. We do this because it's vital for Biblica to help shape the global conversation on AI—ensuring we don't innovate in a vacuum but collaborate generously to share the best ideas and practices.

In Dallas, 561 people came. London drew 160 more. This April, over 1,000 are expected in San Jose for three days of collaboration, discovery, and Kingdom-focused problem-solving.

The caliber speaks for itself—former tech executives, leaders from Meta and Google DeepMind, and theologian Dr. John Lennox, who has written profoundly on AI's implications for humanity. Yet Missional AI isn't about big names—it's about connection. Bible translators meet software engineers. Church planters brainstorm with data scientists.

Biblica leads with radical generosity—sharing everything learned, because the mission is too urgent to hold back.

on streaming platforms like Hulu and Amazon Prime. As the first to freely release our texts through YouVersion’s Bible App, Biblica was honored to be featured in this celebration. Moving toward the next billion Bible downloads, our commitment remains firm: To give all we can to achieve all God wants.

Unburnable: The Bible on Blockchain

Biblica is dedicated to leveraging the latest technology for God’s Kingdom—and our newest innovative way of getting the Bible across borders is impacting access in the world’s most restrictive environments.

In closed countries, owning a physical Bible can mean imprisonment or death. Hostile governments deploy sophisticated firewalls to block online Scripture access. But through blockchain technology, we’re circumventing these barriers to deliver life-changing Bibles to previously unreachable places.

Blockchain offers completely decentralized digital storage that no government or entity can control. Once Scripture is published,

it becomes “immutable”—impossible to change or remove. Most importantly, it’s extremely difficult to block or censor, even by the strongest firewalls.

Biblica has pioneered one of the first “unburnable Bibles”—publishing text, audio, and video Scripture in blockchain format. Disguised as a space exploration website, this tool provides secure access through any web browser without leaving traces on devices.

Working through church planting partners in the Middle East, North Africa, and Central Asia, there is the potential to connect millions in the underground church with God’s Word. With nearly two dozen languages launched, this unburnable Bible is ensuring that sophisticated censorship cannot silence the Gospel.

Through our partnership with YouVersion, Biblica is honored to have played a meaningful part in this achievement, contributing:

Billy Graham & Biblica: A Partnership Spanning Generations



In 1952, Biblica (then the New York Bible Society) partnered with the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association to ensure every new believer received God’s Word at the moment of their life-changing decision. At the time, it would have been difficult to imagine what the future would hold—Billy Graham would go on to preach the Gospel to over 215 million people in 185 countries.

Today, Biblica still partners with this powerful ministry by providing NIV New Testaments given to those who accept Christ through BGEA, changing lives around the world—including some who didn’t intend to attend!

This year in Cochabamba, Bolivia, 8,000 people gave their lives to Christ and received a Spanish New Testament with Psalms and Proverbs.

Among those new believers was sixteen-year-old Manuel, who was simply playing soccer nearby when praise music drew him to investigate. At the stadium, he and his friends heard the Gospel message and made their decision to follow Christ.

“I never thought I could discover a new family,” Manuel shared. “I have placed my life in Jesus, and I will not leave Him. I will read the Bible every day.”

Manuel’s story echoes countless others spanning generations. Each Scripture received represents not just a book, but a foundation for lifelong discipleship and spiritual growth.

This partnership demonstrates the power of placing God’s Word directly into eager hands at the most receptive moment of a person’s spiritual journey.

Since 1952 an unprecedented amount of Scripture has been placed in the hands of new Christians worldwide. Today, New Testaments continue to be distributed to fresh believers, each one representing a transformed life and eternal destiny.

We’re excited to share Biblica’s boldest vision yet: Last Mile First — a groundbreaking initiative to bring first access to God’s Word for the billion people who have been waiting the longest.

The ministry landscape is shifting dramatically. Bible translations are being completed faster than ever, and the church is growing in hard places at unprecedented rates. Yet a stark gap remains: more than one billion people worldwide still lack vital access to the Bible.

This reality demands a fundamental shift in our approach. Instead of asking “Does a Bible translation exist?” we must now ask “Can people actually access and engage it?”

Complex barriers stand between God’s Word and God’s people — hostile governments, religious persecution,

extreme poverty, geographic isolation, and poor connectivity. In the world’s hardest-to-reach places, the church hungers for Scripture but finds it tragically out of reach.

As one church planter in a Muslim-majority country pleads: “There is no way that we can make a disciple if we don’t have a Bible. I’m pleading, I’m pleading, I’m pleading: We need more Bibles.”

Over the next ten years, we will focus 80% of our mission work on the one billion people waiting for their very first taste of the Bible. Through translation, innovation, mobilization, and engagement strategies, we’re committed to closing the final gap between completed translations and transformed lives.

This is our Macedonian call. Will you join us for the life-changing journey of Last Mile First?

ambitious goal: by 2033, our goal is that 95% of the world's population will have access to a full Bible, 99.96% will have access to a New Testament, and 100% will have access to at least some portion of Scripture.

But translation is only the beginning. Our partnership with Close the Bible Gap addresses a critical reality: while God's Church is advancing like never before—growing from 1.4 million churches in 2015 to 10 million—many of these congregations lack basic Bible access. Close the Bible Gap mobilizes resources to bridge this gap,

ensuring that comprehensive Scripture Ecosystem reaches the 1 billion people in remote, restricted, and under-resourced places who have been "last in line for the longest."

Today, thanks to movements like these, God's Word is available to more of the global population than ever before. Every day, we are getting closer to fulfilling the Great Commission. Through teamwork, technology, prayer and generosity, the world is being reached—One Bible, one believer at a time.

We're humbled to link arms with a global alliance committed to eradicating Bible poverty in this generation.
